To set up PowerSchool access as a parent, get your student's **Access ID and Password** from the school, go to your district's PowerSchool portal, click "Create Account," fill in your info, link students using their IDs, and then verify your account via email. You'll use this new login to view grades, attendance, and assignments for your children.

### **Before You Start: Step-by-step Set Up**

**Find the Portal:** Navigate to your school or district's PowerSchool Parent Portal

1. **Start Account Creation:** Click the "Create Account" or "Create Parent Account" button.
2. **Enter Your Info:** Provide your name, a personal email (not a district one), and choose a username (your email is often best) and a strong password.
3. **Link Students:** Under "Link Students to Account," enter the Access ID, Access Password, and your relationship (e.g., Mother, Father, Guardian) for each child. These are case-sensitive.
4. **Submit & Verify:** Click "Enter," then check your email for a verification link from PowerSchool and click it to activate your account.
