


### 4:40pm Teacher's Wish List

The teacher's wish list has been very successful this year and almost all are purchased. Thank you to all who participated.


The virtual Teacher Wish List has been very successful, and we still have till December 31, 2021, before it ends. Teachers are already starting to receive their wish list items.



### 4:52pm: Bowling Fundraiser


Will bring this up to be approved at the next meeting. Will there need to be a minimum number of people? Great for school unity, will send out Be My Valentine to others in the community.

- Each game/shoes is typically \$12.50/person but for a fundraiser, we can charge \$20/person. The school will earn \$7.50 of the \$20.
- If we want to do a raffle or 50/50 or gift basket raffle, we'll need to get a raffle license from city hall. She said that typically costs about \$5 for the day but that might've changed.
